

  - ♦ syn. explode

  - syn. leap forward, overcome an obstacle, push through
  - He's a very talented young actor who's just ready to break through.
  - Scientists think they are beginning to <u>break through</u> in the fight against cancer.
- 10. break up: ayrılmak, okul vb. bitmesi
  - ♦ syn. split, finish
  - He lost his job, and his marriage broke up.
  - The couple broke up last year.

#### 11. bring about: sebep olmak

- ♦ syn. lead to
- How can we <u>bring about</u> a change in attitudes?
- A huge amount of environmental damage has been <u>brought about</u> by the destruction of the rainforests.

# **12. bring up:** yetiştirmek, bahsetmek, konu açmak

- ♦ syn. raise, raise a topic
- He was brought up by his grandparents.
- In my day, children were <u>brought up</u> to respect the law.

#### 13. bump into: rastlamak, karşılaşmak

- syn. meet by chance, encounter, come across
- I <u>bumped into</u> your mother at the supermarket.
- It was great fun and a chance to <u>bump</u> <u>into</u> a few names and faces from the past.

#### 14. burst out: aniden başlamak

- ♦ syn. start suddenly
- Everyone burst out laughing.
- "I don't believe it!" she burst out angrily.

#### 15. call for: gerektirmek

- ♦ syn. require
- Going abroad for further education <u>calls</u> for a great deal of money.
- Finishing this project <u>calls for</u> plenty of experience and vision.

#### 16. call in (on): ziyaret etmek

- ♦ syn. visit
- Could you <u>call in on</u> mum on your way home?
- She wondered whether to *call in on* Mark on the way home.

#### 17. call off: iptal etmek

- ♦ syn. cancel
- The trip to Italy might be <u>called off</u>.
- Rescuers had to <u>call off</u> the search because of worsening weather conditions.

- syn. demand, visit
- She <u>called on</u> the government to hold a vote
- I now <u>call upon</u> the chairman to address the meeting.

#### 19. care for: bakmak, bakımını üstlenmek

- ♦ syn. cherish, look after
- While I'm away, could you <u>care for</u> my elderly relatives?
- <u>Caring for</u> older people in his spare time reveals his kind personality.

#### 20. carry on: devam etmek, sürdürmek

- ♦ syn. continue, keep doing
- Sorry, I interrupted you. Please *carry on*.
- You'll have an accident if you <u>carry on</u> driving like that.
