36. The World Health Organization (W.H.O) has declared an international health emergency over the spread of the Zika virus, now known to cause devastating birth defects. The W.H.O. and the Centres for Disease Control and Prevention have urged pregnant women against travel to more than 45 countries in which the Zika virus is spreading, mostly in the Caribbean and Latin America. All pregnant women who have been to these regions should be tested for the infection, health officials have said, and should refrain from unprotected sex with partners who have visited these regions. ---- In adults, the virus is linked to a form of temporary paralysis, called Guillain-Barré syndrome.
- A) People with Zika virus disease can have symptoms including mild fever, skin rash, conjunctivitis, muscle and joint pain, malaise or headache.
- B) The symptoms are including fever similar to other arbovirus infections such as dengue, skin rashes, conjunctivitis, muscle and joint pain, malaise, and headache.

37. ---- Infant mortality is defined as the death of babies under the age of one year, but some of the differences between countries can be explained with the difference in how we count. Is a baby born weighing less than a pound and after only 21 weeks' gestation actually "born?" In some countries, the answer is no, and those births would be counted as stillbirths. In the United States, on the other hand, despite these premature babies' relatively low odds of survival, they would be considered born -- thus counting toward the country's infant mortality rates. These premature births are the biggest factor in explaining the United States' high infant mortality rate.
